Physical Improvements:

- ❖ Additional verandas, railings and ramps are put in place
- ❖ **NEW!** 'Beautification Yard Program' is implemented including a new 'Welcome' garden and saplings that are planted to provide future shade for visitors
- Haskett Store renovations are completed
- ❖ NEW! Interior of the Office & Gift Shop is renovated / redecorated including a log 'wall' to separate the office area from the reception where visitors are welcomed
- Gift Shop continues to increase its items for sale including locally hand-made gifts as well as the addition of PTM Blacksmith items that are made on site
- Float continues to participate in local parades
- ❖ NEW! Colourful flag pendant at road
- Signage, displays and painting increases around the museum
- Antique donations continue to come in and fill our buildings to capacity for visitors
- Largest 'working' fleet of antique tractors in Southern MB continues to increase
